Where as it is expedient to frame an Direction in respect of Degree of Doctor of Letters (D.Litt.), the Management Council is pleased to make the following ordinance -

- 1) This Direction shall be called " Degree of Doctor of Letters (D.Litt.) ordinance."
- 2) This Direction shall come into force with effect from the date of passing by the Management Council.
- 3) Subject to his compliance with the requirements to this Direction and of other ordinance in force from time to time, any person who has been admitted to the Ph.D. degree of Kavikulaguru Kalidas Sanskrit Vishwavidyalaya or a degree recognised as equivalent thereto in the faculty concerned may submit his application for the award of Degree of Doctor of Letters (D.Litt.)
- 4) Every candidate for the degree shall submit a written application to the Registrar in the prescribed form. His application shall be accompanied by a fee as decided by the authorities from time to time.
- 5) Every candidate for the degree shall submit a treatise(s) which should be his/her original contribution to the advancement of learning. The treatise(s) may either be printed or type written or computer printed.
- 6) The candidate shall submit to the Registrar four copies of the treatise(s) stating its title and clearly indicating the portion of each of which he claims to be original. In case the treatise(s) includes any part of his thesis which may have been submitted earlier for the award of Ph.D. degree or any other research degree he shall clearly so indicate. In case the treatise(s) is an advancement in learning over the previous work submitted by him, he shall specifically indicate accordingly. He shall also indicate the Board of Studies in the University to which the treatise(s) pertains and shall submit a signed declaration that the treatise(s) submitted is not substantially the same as the one which he has already submitted to this university or any other university for the award of Degree of Doctor of Letters (D.litt.) or any other degree.
- 7) i) On fulfilment of the conditions laid down in paragraphs (3) to (6), the treatise(s) shall be placed before the Doctoral Research Committee.  
ii) In case of the candidate who is not having Ph.D. degree but who is submitting the treatise(s) for D.Litt. degree, the Doctoral Research Committee shall co-opt an expert in the subject to ascertain whether the treatise is of sufficient merit to be referred to two examiners appointed by the Board of Examination.

- iii) If the Doctoral Research Committee is of the opinion that the treatise(s) is not of sufficient merit to justify its reference to the examiners, it shall submit its recommendation to the Board of Examination whose decision in the matter shall be final.
- iv) If the Doctoral Research Committee is of the opinion that the treatise(s) is of sufficient merit to justify its reference to the examiners, it shall submit its recommendation to the Board of Examination whose decision in the matter shall be final.
- v) On receipt of such recommendations, the Board of Examination shall submit a panel of not less than four examiners, in order of preference. The treatises will be sent to first two examiners for adjudication. If any one of them or both refuse the appointment the treatises will be sent to subsequent appointees.
- 8) The treatise(s) must be a piece of research work of very high order characterised either by discovery of new facts or by a fresh approach towards interpretation of facts and theories. In either case it should evince candidates capacity for critical examination and sound judgement.
- 9)
  - a) The examiners shall submit their report within three months period to the university. On receipt of the examiners report, it shall be placed before the Academic Council.
  - b) No degree will be awarded to the candidate who's both the reports are not favourably positive and unequivocally recommend the award of degree to the candidate.
  - c) The Academic Council shall decide whether treatise(s) should be the approved for the degree of Doctor of Letters (D.Litt.). If in it's the opinion the treatise(s) is approved, it shall report to the Management Council accordingly.
  - d) The Management Council shall on receipt of the report from the Academic Council declare the treatise(s) approved for the degree of Doctor of Letters (D.Litt.) and shall issue the notification mentioning the name of the candidate who has become eligible for conferment of the degree of Doctor of Letters (D.Litt.)
- 10) The Degree of Doctor of Letters (D.Litt.) shall be awarded to the notified candidate at the University's following annual Convocation.
- 11) **If the examiners consider that the Treatise or Treatises are not of sufficient merit to warrant the conferment of the Degree on the candidate, but that they are of sufficient merit to warrant the conferment of the lesser Degree of Doctor of Philosophy (Ph.D.), they shall report accordingly give a concise statement of the grounds on which their conclusion is based. On receipt of such report, the Board of Examination shall declare the Treatise or Treatises approved as thesis for the Degree of Doctor of Philosophy and shall notify the name of the candidate and the subject of his thesis.**
